# Spotlight: 6<sup>th</sup> District Libraries



## Burnett Neighborhood Library

Although Burnett Neighborhood Library was built in 1969, many Long Beach residents consider it as the first branch library! The original Burnett Neighborhood Library was located in a Burnett Elementary School classroom in 1910 and moved to its present site in 1924. The premises contain a teen center, two patios, a cozy auditorium, and the beloved papier-mâché statues of Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs that headline the children department. Still going strong after four decades, the dedicated staff at Burnett Neighborhood Library provides plenty of programs and services for local patrons. Some of the resources and enrichment programs provided are:

- 18 up-to-date computers that allow the public to access the main library database, Internet usage, educational material, and project templates.
- A Summer Reading Program for youth (5-18) and adults, plus classroom visits.
- Adult programming with an ESL (English as a Second Language) Conversation Club.
- Programs that help residents create top-notch résumés and find career/employment opportunities.
- Holds one of the largest collections of African-American historical records and literature in the nation.
- The Family Learning Center provides homework assistance to students in grades K - 8. Alongside academic mentors, parents can engage with their children to see them grow in all fields. The center is staffed with homework helpers to provide assistance with assignments and computer instructions.

## Mark Twain Library

The newly constructed Mark Twain Library is the largest branch library in the City of Long Beach. Originally known as the Central Branch Library, it was renamed in honor of classic American author, Samuel Clemens, also known as Mark Twain. The establishment is the first library in Long Beach to receive the Silver Medal LEED (Leaders in Energy and Environmental Design) Award from the U.S. Green Building Council. The building was designed and constructed to conserve natural resources, increase energy efficiency, and improve indoor air quality – a showcase of the City of Long Beach's "going green" initiative. Some amazing highlights to make note are:

- A Mark Twain Library Book Club that creates discussions and a cup or two of tea. Meetings take place on the 2nd Wednesday of each month from 11 am to 12 noon. Every month a new book is selected.
- Hosts an impressive collection of fiction and non-fiction works, periodicals and newspapers, African-American literature and collections of materials in Khmer, Vietnamese and Spanish.
- Programs include the pre-school, tiny tot, and family story times. In addition, the library offers summer reading programs for children, teens, and adults.
- State-of-the-art conference room, aquarium, storytelling area with a wall-size "pop up" book, public art reading "benches" and auditorium.
- Year-round programs to improve literacy and understandings of various cultures.





Have a problem you want to report?

### POTHOLE? GRAFFITI?? TRASH & LITTER???

Say no more, for the City of Long Beach is getting with these modern times. And it only takes 3 minutes of one's time. Here's what you must do:

- 1.) Download the “**Go Long Beach**” app from any smart phone device.
- 2.) Once the app has finished downloading, report your issue by clicking the “New Issue” button.
- 3.) A link should appear revealing a wide array of constituent-related issues (ex. ‘graffiti’).
- 4.) Once you have selected your concern from the list, add other pieces of information, such as your name, email, phone number, and even personal comments.
- 5.) The GPS of one's smart phone device should locate the correct address of where the issue takes place. If the address is incorrect, one may also manually change the location.
- 6.) Once the report is finalized and submitted, one can track the progress of their issue. The issue should be resolved in less than two weeks.




