

Did You Know?

- The Long Beach Airport Area Complex supports 43,000 jobs.
- The Long Beach Police Department established LB COPS, one of the first real time crime analysis systems to connect databases to live camera feeds.
- Long Beach is the largest city in the CalPERS retirement system to achieve full pension reform, with all City employees paying their full share of pension costs.
- Nationally, Long Beach has been named a Top 10 Social Media City two years in a row.
- The Port of Long Beach moves more than \$150 billion a year in trade.
- In 2012, the City of Long Beach was designated a Silver-Level Walk Friendly Community for walkability initiatives and programs.
- The City is the largest municipality in California to reward residents for recycling.
- Three Long Beach Marinas – Shoreline, Rainbow and Alamitos Bay – have been recertified as “Clean Marinas” by the Clean Marinas Program.
