On Tuesday, November 6, 2018, the City of Long Beach will consolidate an election with the Statewide General Election at which voters will consider a ballot measure related to **Hotel Workplace Requirements and Restrictions**.

For this election, the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk will conduct the election and mail the Official Sample Ballot Booklet to all Long Beach voters. The Official Sample Ballot Booklet includes the ballot title, the impartial analysis, proposed measure text, direct arguments for and against, and rebuttal arguments.

On **Tuesday, August 14, 2018** the City Council will consider appointments of argument writers, as designated by the Mayor.

Direct arguments shall not exceed 300 words and are due to the Office of the City Clerk by **Friday, August 17, 2018** by 4:30 p.m.

Rebuttal arguments shall not exceed 250 words and are due to the Office of the City Clerk by **Tuesday, August 27, 2018** by 4:30 p.m.

To be considered for an argument writer, complete this interest form and return it to the Office of the City Clerk by **4:30 p.m. on Friday, August 10, 2018. No postmarks will be accepted.**
