3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH  
5 MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 10.32.110  
6 RELATING TO PREFERENTIAL PARKING DISTRICT "U";  
7 DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF; AND DECLARING  
8 THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT  
9 IMMEDIATELY

11 WHEREAS, residents on Los Santos Drive between Chatwin Avenue and  
12 Garford Street have requested inclusion in Preferential Parking District "U" to seek on-  
13 street parking relief due to overflow parking generated by California State University Long  
14 Beach students; and

15 WHEREAS, the residents have requested that a one-hour parking  
16 restriction, from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except Saturdays,  
17 Sundays and holidays, be established within the proposed preferential parking district  
18 expansion; and

19 WHEREAS, a parking study conducted by the Department of Public Works  
20 staff during the peak period of activity on Los Santos Drive revealed that eighty-six  
21 percent (86%) of existing on-street parking spaces within the block area requested were  
22 occupied at the time of the survey and that ninety percent (90%) of the vehicles were not  
23 registered to residents of the neighborhood; and

24 WHEREAS, a petition formally requesting the expansion of Preferential  
25 Parking District "U" and a one-hour parking restriction from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.,  
26 Monday through Friday, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, was circulated among  
27 the residents; and

28 WHEREAS, a review of the petition by staff revealed that eighty-nine

1 percent (89%) of the residents of the block supported their inclusion of implementing a  
2 preferential parking district and the proposed parking restrictions; and

3 WHEREAS, the City Traffic Engineer has reviewed the results of the  
4 parking study, the resident petition and the feedback responses from the mailing, and he  
5 has determined that conditions meet minimum municipal code criteria as outlined in  
6 LBMC 10.32.020 for inclusion in the preferential parking district;

7 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach does  
8 hereby ordain as follows:

10 Section 1. District "U" of Section 10.32.110 of the Long Beach Municipal  
11 Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 District U: The west side of Britton Drive between Atherton Street and  
13 Marita Street; both sides of Britton Drive between Marita Street and Los Santos  
14 Drive; both sides of Marita Street between Britton Drive and Fanwood Avenue;  
15 both sides of Lave Avenue between Atherton Street and Los Santos Drive; the  
16 east side of San Anseline Avenue between Atherton Street and Los Santos Drive;  
17 both sides of San Vicente Avenue between Marita Street and Los Santos Drive;  
18 both sides of Garford Street between San Vicente Avenue and Los Santos Drive;  
19 both sides of Fairbrook Street between San Vicente Avenue and Los Santos  
20 Drive; north side of Los Santos Drive between Chatwin Avenue and San Anseline  
21 Avenue; both sides of Los Santos Drive between San Anseline Avenue and  
22 Garford Street/Ocana Avenue; both sides of Chatwin Avenue between Atherton  
23 Street and Garford Street; both sides of Marber Avenue between Atherton Street  
24 and Garford Street; both sides of Garford Street Between Marber Avenue and San  
25 Anseline Avenue; both sides of San Anseline Avenue between Los Santos Drive  
26 and Garford Street; and both sides of Lave Avenue between Los Santos Drive and  
27 Britton Drive.

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I further certify that thereafter, at the same meeting, upon a roll call and vote on adoption of the ordinance, it was adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach by the following vote:


