All peace officer personnel records, including information relating to specific deliberations of the Citizen Police Complaint Commission and findings by the City Manager, shall be kept confidential to the extent required by law. In order to comply with this requirement, certain information may have been withheld in this report.

After its July 12, 2018 meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the July 12, 2018 meeting are:

**COMMISSION**

- Sustained - 4 allegations
- Other – 5 allegations
- Exonerated - 4 allegations
- Not Sustained - 7 allegations
- Re-Investigate – 1 allegation
- Unfounded – 0 allegations

**CITY MANAGER**

- Sustained - 4 allegation
- Other – 3 allegations
- Exonerated - 4 allegations
- Not Sustained - 6 allegations
- Re-Investigate – 1 allegation
- Unfounded – 3 allegations

The Commission submitted recommendations for the Long Beach Police Department to review and update policy regarding accepting electronic proof of insurance. The Commission believes this should not be the Officer's discretion. Additionally, the Commission requests an update regarding whether ticket books have been updated.
