All peace officer personnel records, including information relating to specific deliberations of the Citizen Police Complaint Commission and findings by the City Manager, shall be kept confidential to the extent required by law. In order to comply with this requirement, certain information may have been withheld in this report.

After its **August 11, 2016** monthly meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the **August 11, 2016** are:

- Sustained – two allegations
- Not sustained – nine allegations
- Unfounded – five allegations
- Exonerated – 10 allegations

CITY MANAGER

- Sustained – two allegations
- Not sustained – nine allegations
- Unfounded – five allegations
- Exonerated – 10 allegations

Recommendation

- The Commission recommends that the City Manager direct the Long Beach Police Department to review and update its policies regarding arrestees wearing religious head garments, hijabs and turbans. The Commission recommends that the LBPD consider the Dearborn, Michigan's policy in this area. The Commission respectfully requests a report in 60 days.
