Subject: **Status Update – 8 by 28 Initiative**

On February 6, 2018, the City Council requested the City Manager to prepare an “8 by 28” plan, a needs assessment, and project timeline for eight projects that are critical to a successful 2028 Summer Olympics and Paralympic Games; and, to prioritize and brand these projects as Olympic priority developments for future funding opportunities.

The “8 by 28” projects are:

- Belmont/Veterans Pier Rebuild
- Belmont Pool
- Lifeguard Towers
- Beach Concession Stands
- Arena Improvements
- Convention Center Hotel
- Airport Improvements
- Blue Line Improvements

City staff is working to finalize an update for each of the projects under the “8 by 28” initiative. The update will provide details on each project, including a project description, timeline, and funding status. Details about the benefits and impacts to the City, along with a summary of future City Council action, will be also included. We anticipate submitting an update by the end of June 2018.
