## WHAT IS HEPATITIS A?

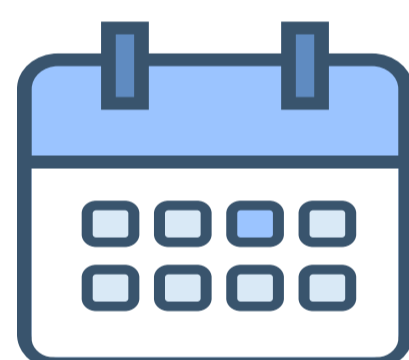
Hepatitis A is a liver disease caused by the hepatitis virus. It is highly contagious, and can cause serious illness and even death.

## AM I AT RISK?

In the past year, there were outbreaks of hepatitis A in neighboring counties, primarily affecting people who are experiencing homelessness, illicit drug users, or men who have sex with men.

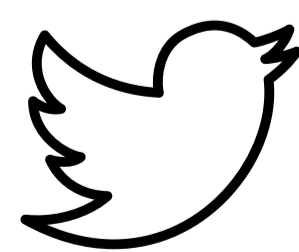
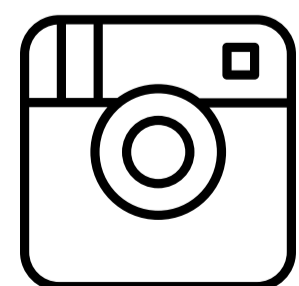
