

Waiting for your Zika Test Results



While waiting for results, it's important that you:

- ✓ Prevent yourself from getting mosquito bites. This is important in order to prevent the spread of Zika
- ✓ Don't have unprotected sex
- ✓ Let us know if anyone else around you develops symptoms of Zika (rash, fever, red eyes, and joint pain) by calling (562) 570-4302

How will I get my results?

- ✓ We may run many different tests. It can take from 2-4 weeks to get your results
- ✓ Additional blood and urine samples may be requested at a later date
- ✓ Your doctor will give you your results
- ✓ Follow up with your doctor if you don't receive your results 1 month after getting tested

Zika and Sex

- Zika virus can spread during sex by an infected person to female or male partners
- Either do not have sex or use condoms during vaginal, anal, and oral sex
- Talk to your doctor if you are thinking about getting pregnant

Mosquito Prevention

- Dump and drain standing water in and around your home once a week
- Use insect repellent when outside
- Wear long sleeves while outdoors
- Avoid unnecessary travel to areas with Zika
