July 16, 2019 Tue	City Council adopted resolution for the Placement of a General Tax Measure on the Ballot of the March 3, 2020 Special Municipal Election for submission to the qualified voters of the City of Long Beach and amended ordinance to extend and adjust the rate of a Transactions and Use Tax, and making findings of fiscal emergency pursuant to California Proposition 218.
November 12, 2019 Tue	City Council adopted resolution Amending the Ballot Label/Ballot Question for a General Tax Measure Placed on the March 3, 2020 Special Municipal Election Ballot Relating to an Amended Ordinance to Extend and Adjust the Rate of The City's Transactions and Use Tax.
November 19, 2019 Tue	City Council adopted resolution for the Placement of a General Tax Measure on the Ballot of the March 3, 2020 Special Municipal Election for submission to the qualified voters of the City of Long Beach an ordinance amending Long Beach Municipal Code section 3.64.035, to increase the rate of the general purpose Transient Occupancy (Hotel) Tax from 6% to 7%, and making findings of fiscal emergency pursuant to California Proposition 218.
December 3, 2019	Last regular council meeting to adopt resolution calling the election; Mayor calls for argument writers
December 3, 2019 Tue E-91	The Mayor, with the approval of the City Council, may designate a person, or association of persons, to write arguments either for or against or both for and against the adoption of any measure or proposition placed on the ballot. (L.B.M.C. 1.24.020)
December 6, 2019 Fri E-88	The legislative body of the city may submit to the voters, without a petition therefor, a proposition for the repeal, amendment, or enactment of any ordinance, to be voted upon at any succeeding regular or special city election, and if the proposition submitted receives a majority of the votes cast on it at the election, the ordinance shall be repealed, amended, or enacted accordingly. A proposition may be submitted, or a special election may be called for the purpose of voting on a proposition, by ordinance or resolution. The election shall be held not less than 88 days after the date of the order of election. (E.C. 9222) Last day to submit resolution to consolidate with Los Angeles County.
December 13, 2019 Fri E-81	Arguments for or against any measure or proposition shall not exceed three hundred (300) words each, and shall be submitted to the City Clerk on or before the date set by the City Clerk to permit the preparation of rebuttal arguments as provided in this Chapter. All dates relating to the submission of arguments or rebuttal arguments shall be set by the City Clerk to ensure timely printing of the arguments and rebuttal arguments for the sample ballots required by law. (L.B.M.C. 1.24.030)
December 13, 2019 Fri E-81	City Attorney to prepare Impartial Analysis. Impartial Analysis not to exceed 500 words (L.B.M.C. 1.24.100, E.C. 9280). LARRCC election calendar deadline to submit impartial analysis is E-81.

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December 14, 2019 Sat E-80	10-calendar-day public inspection of arguments begins (E.C. 9286).
December 23, 2019 Mon E-71	10-calendar-day public inspection of arguments ends (E.C. 9286).
December 23, 2019 Mon E-71	Last day to submit rebuttal arguments (E.C. 9285)
December 24, 2019 Tue E-70	10-calendar-day public inspection of rebuttal arguments begins (E.C. 9295).
January 2, 2020 Thu E-61	10-calendar-day public inspection of rebuttal arguments ends (E.C. 9295).
January 23, 2020 Thu E-40	Mailing of sample ballots begins (E.C. 13303).
February 18, 2020 Tue E-14	Last day to register to vote. (E.C. 2102) *Date extended by one day due to holiday <i>Conditional voter registration will allow citizens to register to vote at every vote center in Los Angeles County through the Voting Solutions for All People software.</i>
February 25, 2020 Tue E-7	Last day to request a Vote by Mail ballot (E.C. 3001)
March 3, 2020 Tue E	Election Day
April 2, 2020 Thu E+30	LARRCC shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit to the governing body within 30 days of the election (E.C. 15372).
