All peace officer personnel records, including information relating to specific deliberations of the Citizen Police Complaint Commission and findings by the City Manager, shall be kept confidential to the extent required by law. In order to comply with this requirement, certain information may have been withheld in this report.

After its October 11, 2018 meeting, the Citizen Police Complaint Commission submitted recommendations to the City Manager.

The Commission's recommendations and the City Manager's findings for some allegations considered during the October 11, 2018 meeting are:

COMMISSION

- Exonerated – 6 allegations
- Not Sustained - 2 allegations
- Unfounded – 6 allegations
- Sustained – 2 allegations
- Other – 2 allegations

CITY MANAGER

- Exonerated – 10 allegations
- Not Sustained – 2 allegations
- Unfounded – 4 allegations
- Sustained – 0 allegations
- Other – 2 allegations

The Commission submitted a request for the Long Beach Police Department to provide information on the policies and practices concerning the property of juveniles who are arrested. Additionally, The Commission has concerns about booking someone solely for smoking a cigarette. The Commission believes that the “no smoking” sign in the bus area is too small and questions if it should be enforced.
