**RE: Support for SB 90 (Wiener)—Insulin Affordability Act**

Dear Senator Wiener,

On behalf of the City of Long Beach, I write in support of SB 90. This bill would prohibit health insurers and health maintenance organizations (HMOs) from imposing a deductible on insulin and caps copayments at \$35 for a 30-day supply of insulin. SB 90 aligns with the City's objectives to support legislation that ensures access to affordable medical, dental, and mental health care.

Diabetes is among the top six causes of death in Long Beach. Furthermore, more than half of the patients hospitalized for COVID-19 have diabetes as an underlying health condition. According to the [Community Health Assessment](#), 9.7% of adults in Long Beach reported having been diagnosed with diabetes. The census tracts with the highest proportion of adults with diabetes are mostly in the western parts of the City, and the census tract with the highest percentage of adults with diabetes is towards the east, with 20.1% of adults reporting having been diagnosed. This population relies on daily doses of insulin for survival. Without access to insulin, patients are at risk for other serious health complications such as cardiovascular disease, blindness, kidney disease, and death.

SB 90 will protect patient health and safety by ensuring access to insulin for those who depend on it. This bill is a critical step forward toward building a healthier and brighter future for all. For these reasons, the City supports SB 90.
