- ▶ Mobile shredding truck on-site until truck gets full

Accepted:

Confidential documents, white or colored paper, manila file folders, and envelopes.

NOT Accepted:

Hanging file folders, metal objects, plastics, glass, plastic bags, food materials, batteries, weapons, hard drives, cell phones, 3-ring binders, cardboard or wet material.
