Subject: **Save the Date - Beach Streets Downtown Open Streets Event**

We are excited to announce that "Beach Streets Downtown," an open streets event, is scheduled for Saturday, May 20, 2023, from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Beach Streets Downtown route features Pine Avenue from 8th Street to 1st Street, Broadway from Pine Avenue to Euclid Avenue, Linden Avenue from 1st Street to 4th Street, Cherry Avenue from 2nd Street to 4th Street, 4th Street from Cherry Avenue to Junipero Avenue, and 1st and 2nd Streets between Cherry Avenue and Junipero Avenue. This event, sponsored by Metro, allows for walking, bicycling, skating and socializing by temporarily closing the streets to vehicular traffic.

Entertainment hubs along the route will feature music, kids' activities, food trucks and more.

Open street events promote the pursuit of innovative strategies to achieve environmental, social, economic and public health goals. By repurposing streets for cyclists, pedestrians and other non-motorized users, cities are encouraged to consider other ways our streets can be used.
