Subject: Schedule for Citywide Community Meetings on the Fiscal Year 2024 Budget

The City of Long Beach (City) is kicking off the Fiscal Year 2024 (FY 24) Budget development process, which prepares for the fiscal year from October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024. The early community engagement process started a year ago in response to a request by the Mayor and the City Council. The early community engagement process supports the City’s goals outlined in the Framework for Reconciliation.

In January, the City will host four in-person citywide community meetings, followed by one virtual meeting in early February. At each community meeting, residents and community members will share their priorities on City services and engage in conversation with the City Manager, and other Department representatives. A general budget priority survey will be online starting Wednesday, January 18, 2023 through Tuesday, February 7, 2023. The comments and feedback from these channels will be synthesized and reported to the City Council prior to the Proposed FY 24 Budget being developed.

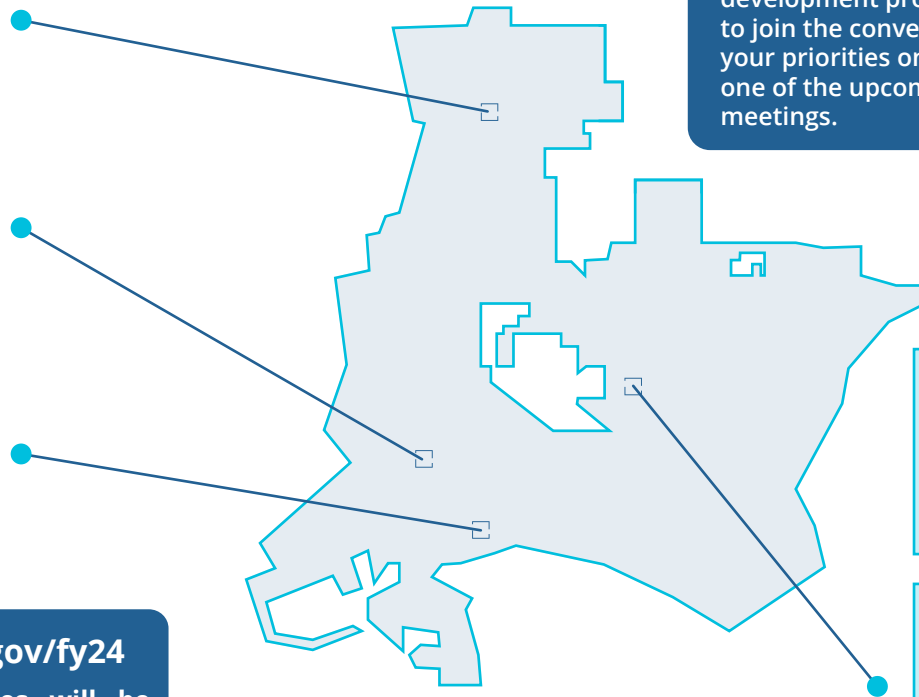
