Subject: **Update on the Citizen Police Complaint Commission (CPCC) Website**

On July 11, 2023, the Mayor and City Council requested the City Manager check the CPCC website to verify that information on how to file a police complaint is clearly posted. Staff has confirmed that the [CPCC website](#) and information on how to file a complaint after the passage of Measure E is posted on the main page of the website for public view.

Beginning January 1, 2023, the CPCC stopped taking new police complaints, and all police complaints have been solely filed with the Internal Affairs Division of the Long Beach Police Department (LBPd) for investigation. This is consistent with their primary authority for investigations as outlined in Measure E.
