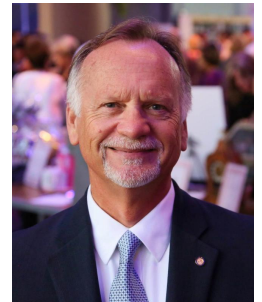

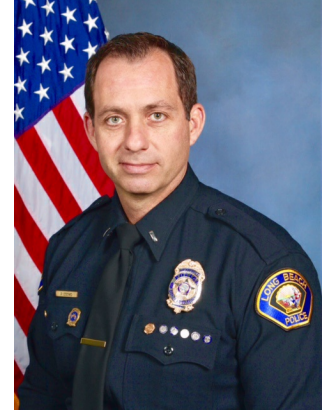


Past Events

Thursday, August 9th | 6:30 P.M. | 7550 E. Spring St.

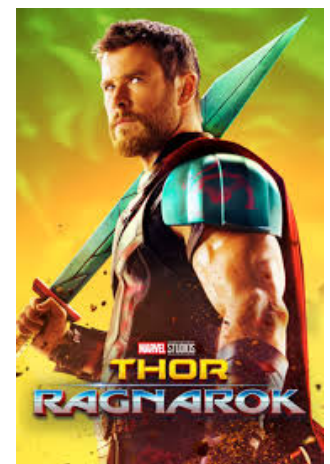

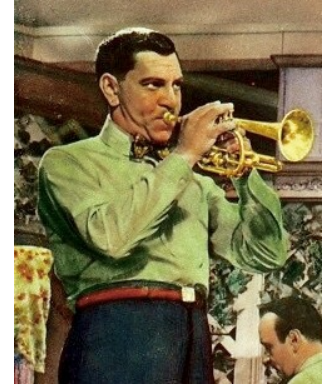

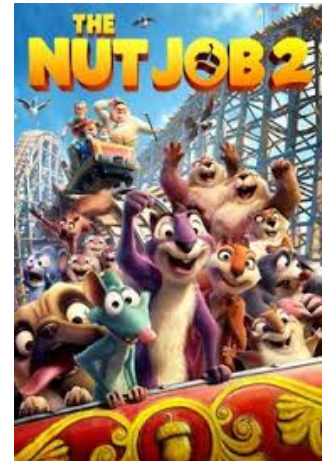

And Finally

Mid-Century Modernism Revisited

With Ralphs appearing in today's newsletter, we thought we'd revisit the architectural gem that once stood on the same parcel of land. The photo below shows the Duffield Lincoln Mercury showroom at the N/E corner of Lakewood Blvd. and Outer Traffic Circle as it looked in 1963. The building's modernism design, by Long Beach architects Killingsworth, Brady and Smith, created a sense that the ultra-thin roof was floating above the showroom. The same recessed ceiling lights were used in both the interior and exterior of the showroom which was delineated by floor-to-ceiling glass. The dealership was renamed Murphy Lincoln Mercury before it was demolished to make way for the AutoZone that occupies the corner today.
