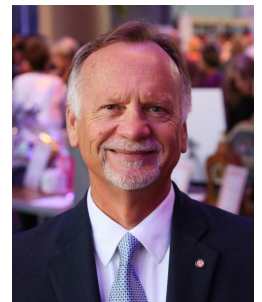

### Save the Date: CHLB Special Meeting

October 16th | 6:30 pm - 8 pm | 5001 Deukmeijan Dr.

We will be hosting a very special meeting on Tuesday, October 16th at the Recreation Park Clubhouse. The city council meeting for that date has been cancelled, so we can devote our full attention to Community Hospital. The purpose of the meeting is to get the public's input on what services they would like to have at the hospital. It will be the residents' opportunity to express their vision on what should be included with the ER and acute care hospital. The operator of the new hospital, Molina Wu Network, will provide a presentation and gather input from the audience. ### New Utility Payment Policy - No More Fees!

City of Long Beach utility customers will no longer be charged a convenience fee when paying their bill, effective, Monday, October

8, 2018. Eliminating these convenience fees to consumers provides a better customer service experience for those who pay by credit or debit card and avoids an additional charge of \$3.75 per payment and \$0.95 for utility customers paying by eCheck. **LB Open Studio Tour**

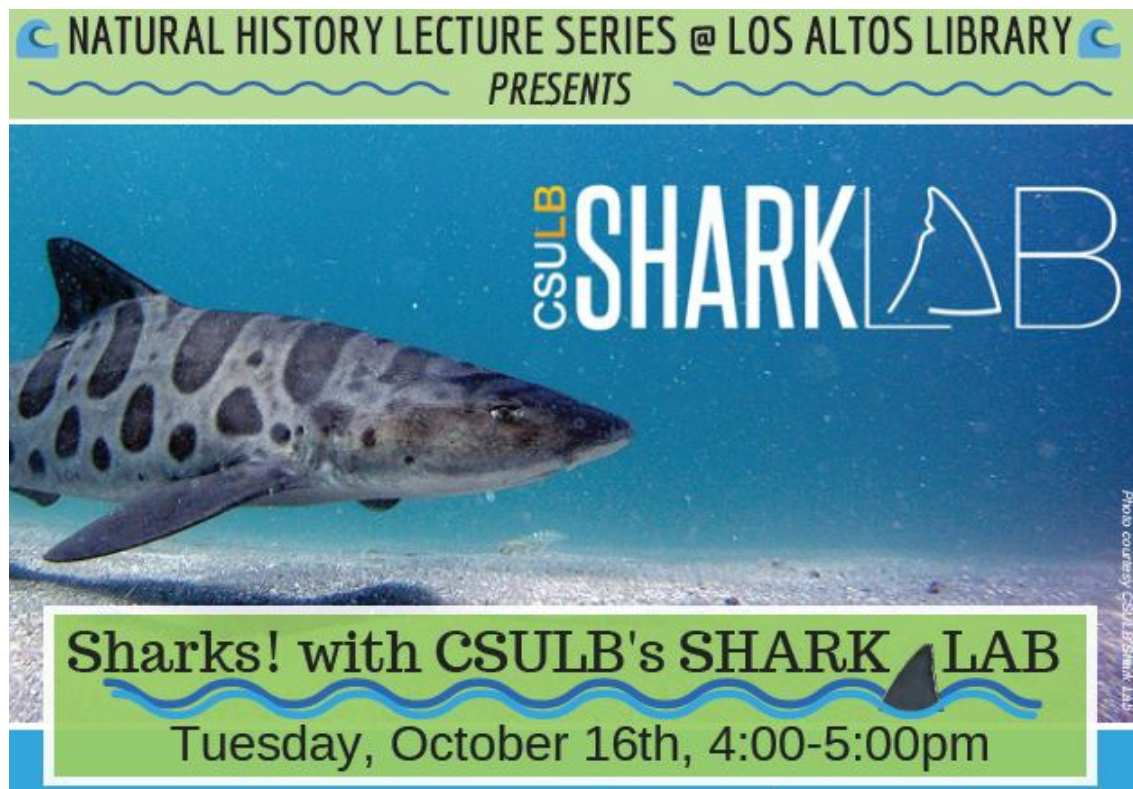
October 13-14, 20-21 and 27-28 | 12 pm - 5 pm

**LBFD Training Center: Live Burn Schedule**

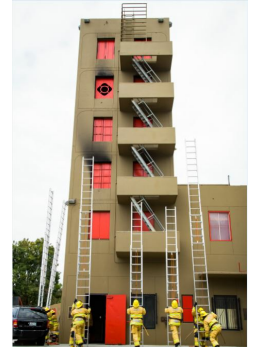

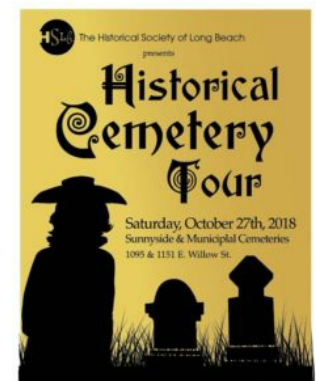

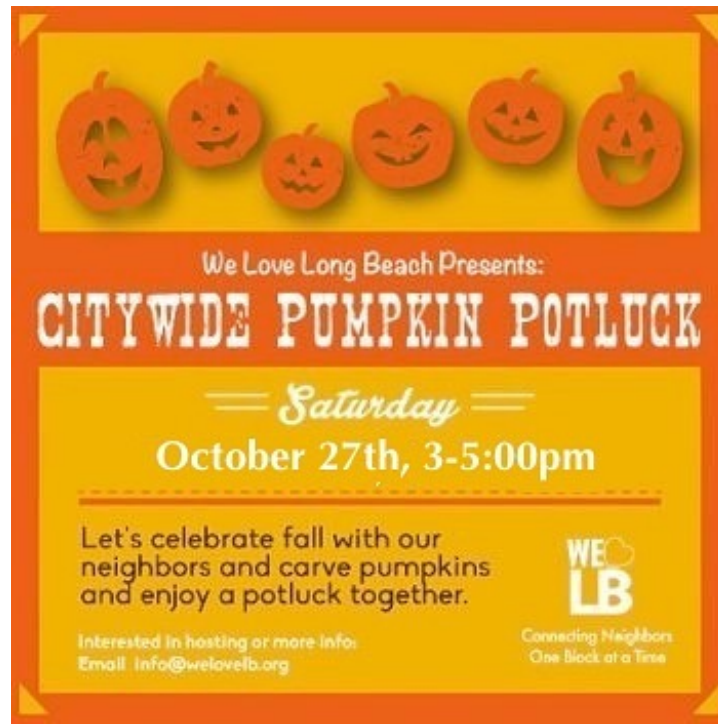
## 23rd Annual Historical Cemetery Tour

## Nature Center Howl-oween

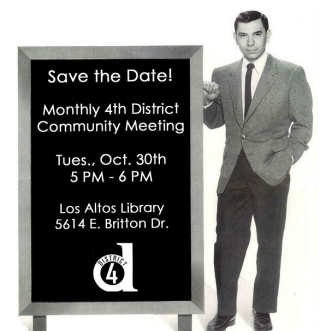
