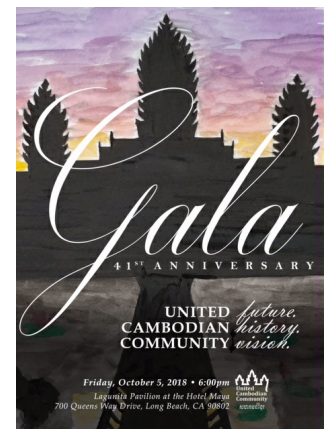

## Long Beach Marathon CD4 Street Closures October 7th | Various Locations

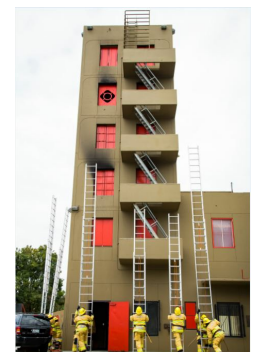

- Thursday, October 11th from 2:45 pm to 5 pm



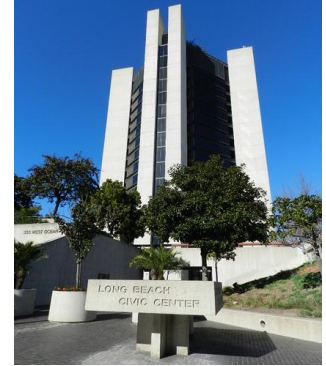

## Next on the Council Agenda

The City Council meeting is scheduled to begin at 5 p.m. in the council chambers on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 333 W. Ocean Blvd. City council meetings are broadcast live online and are also available on Channel 3 for Charter cable subscribers and Channel 21 for FIOS subscribers. Here are some of the topics that will be discussed at Tuesday's city council meeting:



- The Council will discuss a recommendation to authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute agreements with the Long Beach Unified School District for the operation of the After School Education and Safety Program at various elementary schools including Herrera.
- The Council will consider a recommendation to request City Manager to work with Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design certified members of the LBPD and report back with specific recommendations on how individual public spaces such as parks can discourage crime through environmental design.

**October 13-14, 20-21 and 27-28 | 12 pm - 5 pm**

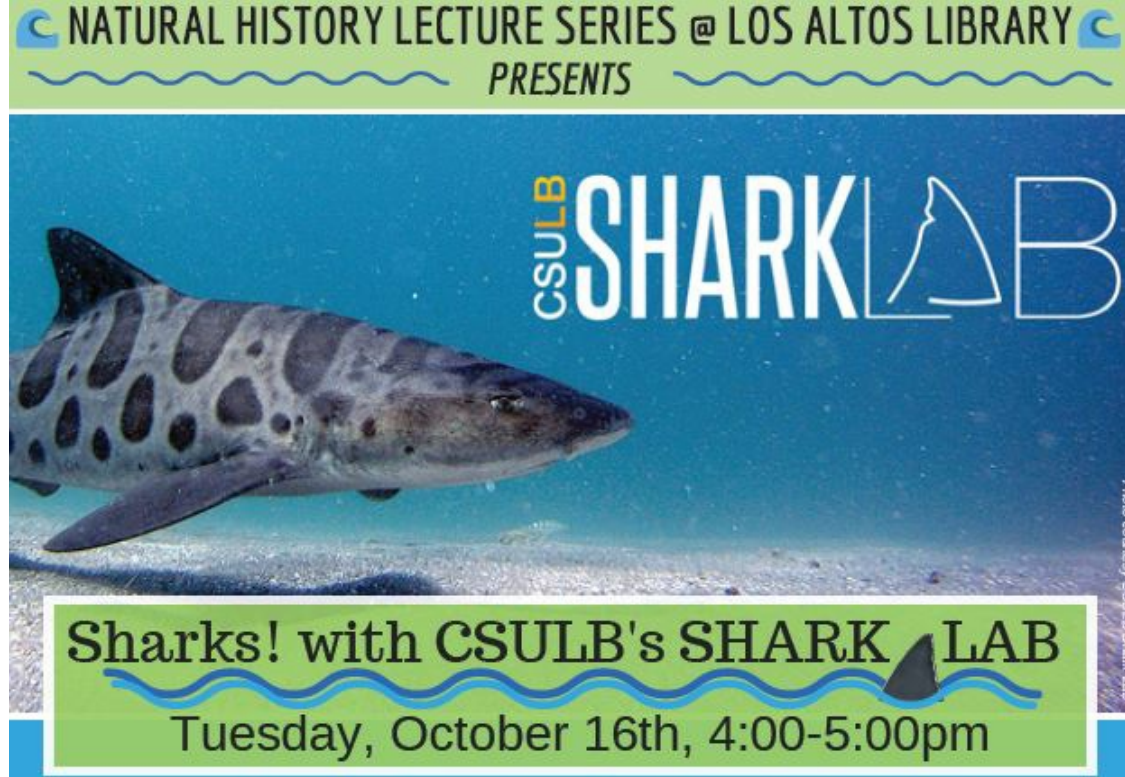

## Save the Date: WomenShelter's "Lead with Love"

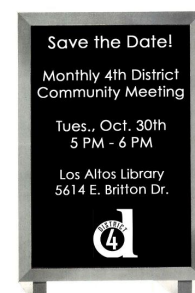
