



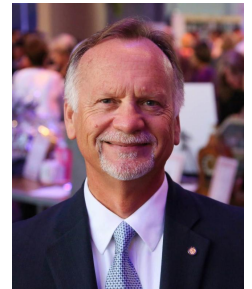

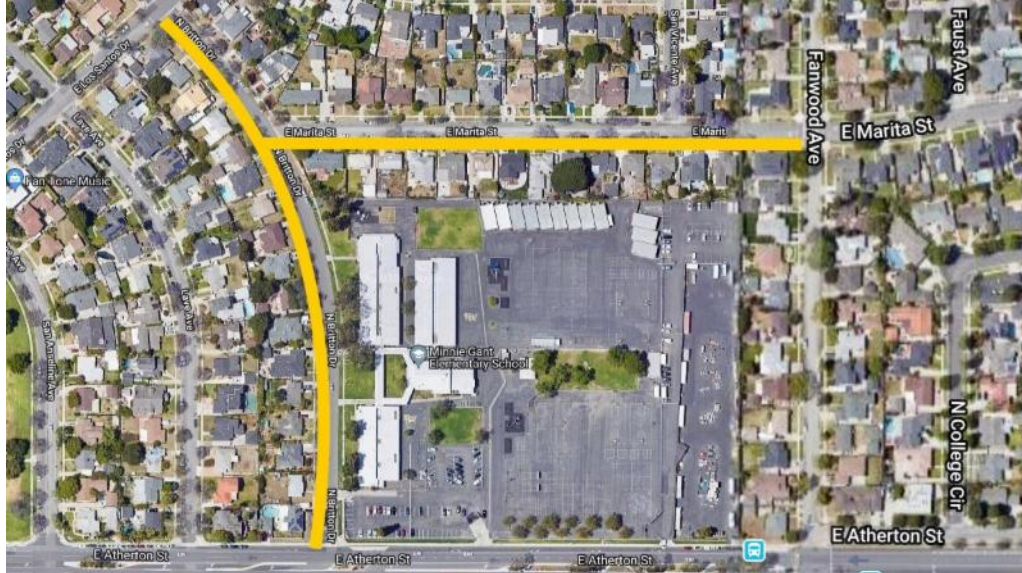

Gas Pipeline Replacement Project Near Minnie Gant

Long Beach Energy Resources (LBER) has started a gas main and gas service pipeline replacement project near Minnie Gant School. The work will be on Britton Drive from Atherton Street to Los Santos Drive, and on Marita Street from Britton Drive to Fanwood Avenue. The project start date was July 22nd, and the work hours are 7:00 am to 4:30 pm. The estimated duration of the project is 60 business days. However, LBER is aware the school's start date is August 28th, and they plan on completing the work on Britton Drive prior to the start of the school year. 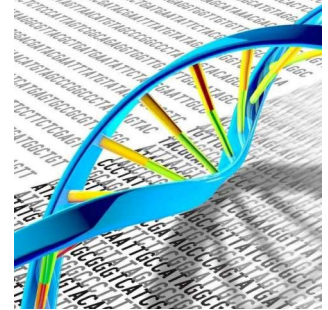


Commercial Genetic Testing Presentation

The Ximeno Curve

The Ximeno Curve refers to a section of Ximeno Avenue that runs between 15th Street and Pacific Coast Highway. Ximeno was originally a straight, north/south street that connected to PCH just S/E of the traffic circle. The intersection still exists today between FreeConferenceCall and Kelly Williams Insurance. It was changed in 1949 to make way for construction of the Circle Drive-In. While the drive-in is long gone, the curved section of Ximeno, which is also on a hill, still remains. Our Public Works Department is now planning a bike lane on this curved incline. Our office will be examining the design to make sure safety, parking and traffic flow are maintained. We will keep you informed with regular project updates in the weeks to come.
