



# **Digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record Now Available**

If you tried to sign up for a COVID-19 vaccination digital record and ran into a snag, CDPH is reporting the system has been fixed. Just enter a few details on the online form to get a link to a QR code and digital copy of your COVID-19 vaccination record. If you want to share your proof of vaccination, you can use either the electronic version you'll get from the portal or the card you were given at time of vaccination. ## **Commercial Rental Assistance Grant Program**

Application period: June 11 - July 22, 2021

The City is launching a grant program that will help small

businesses pay their commercial rent, if they have lost revenue as a result of COVID-19 and State and Local Health Orders that restricted business operations. Grants totaling \$4,000 are available to help businesses pay commercial lease payments that are outstanding or will become due in the 2021 calendar year. The Commercial Rental Assistance Grant application period begins June 11, 2021, at noon and closes Thursday, July 22, 2021, at 5 p.m. To apply, businesses may visit the City's

# **Rental Assistance Program Extended (Again)**

New application deadline: July 11, 2021

The City is extending the deadline again for residential landlords and tenants to submit applications for the Long Beach Emergency Rental Assistance Program (LB-ERAP) by 30 days. All LB-ERAP applications can be submitted via an online information and service portal at longbeach.gov/erap. The program provides rental assistance to residential landlords and income-eligible tenants in Long Beach who have experienced

The City's Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine (PRM) will offer the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) to provide free, nutritious meals to Long Beach children and youth throughout the summer months. Beginning June 21 through August 27, PRM will provide free meals for children and youth Monday through Friday, 11:30 am to 12:30 pm (excluding July 5th). Meals will be available to all attending children and youth between one and 18 years old. Infant meals will not be provided. ### F/A-18 Operations at LGB This Weekend

Fri - Sun | June 25th - 27th | Long Beach Airport

The U.S. Navy has informed LGB that two (2) F/A-18 aircraft will be conducting training operations at Long Beach Airport on Friday, June 25 through Sunday, June 27. It is anticipated that these aircraft will arrive Friday evening and conduct a few training operations on Saturday prior to departing Sunday morning, but all times are tentative and subject to change. LGB will be informing the community via WebTrak, social media and LGB's website. The aircraft will use noise abatement procedures when operating near Long Beach. These procedures include modified arrival and departure flight profiles and minimum use of afterburners.



# **LBPD Holding DUI Checkpoint TONIGHT**

June 25th | 6 pm - 2 am | LBPD East Division

The Long Beach Police Department will hold a DUI Checkpoint on June 25th from 6:00 pm to 2:00 am in the East Patrol Division. Checkpoint locations are chosen based on a history of DUI crashes and arrests. The primary purpose of checkpoints is not to make arrests, but to promote public safety by deterring

Stearns Park will be the site of in person adaptive recreation programs for middle and high school youth and adults. Programs begin on Monday, 6/21, and will provide fun and enriching experiences such as art, games and fitness activities designed for people with special needs. The Adaptive Youth and Adult Recreation Programs will take place Monday through Friday. The middle and high school programs, for youth grades six through 12, will take place from 9:30 am to 1:30 pm, and the adult program will take place from 2 to 5 pm. The program cost



is \$20 per week for youth and \$15 for adults. Both programs will maintain appropriate staff-to-participant ratios and other enhanced safety protocols for the health and safety of both participants and staff. ## **City Council Enhances Fireworks Penalties**

The City will provide ongoing enforcement of illegal firework activity in the days leading up to and including the Fourth of July weekend. Anyone cited or arrested for fireworks violations may face a \$1,000 fine, a jail sentence for six months, or both. On June 15, the City Council unanimously approved an increased administrative penalty with recovery costs for illegal fireworks citations. Reporting illegal firework activity by community members can contribute to the City's enforcement efforts. # FREE 4th of July "Fireworks-Free" Block Party Permits

All block parties involving closure of a residential or business street require a Block Party Permit. The City of Long Beach is waiving the \$100 fee for all City-approved block parties hosted on July 4, 2021. Block Party Coordinators/Applicants must ensure a safe and fireworks-free event.
