Past and Ongoing Events

Celebrating LGB's New Baggage Claim!

Yesterday, Long Beach Airport (LGB) commemorated the opening of its new Baggage Claim facility. The project is part of a multi-year, Phase II - Terminal Area Improvement Program to enhance the passenger experience. Funding for the new Baggage Claim comes from Airport revenue, bond proceeds and Passenger Facility Charges (PFCs), a passenger fee that may be used for Federal Aviation Administration-approved projects. Long Beach Airport is a self-supporting enterprise of the City of Long Beach and does not receive local tax dollars. Read the press release at this [link](#).



Congressman Garcia Proposes Project Funding

Congressman Robert Garcia announced yesterday his submissions of Community Project Funding requests to the House Committee on Appropriations for funding in the FY2024 cycle. These projects aim to serve communities throughout the district by providing federal funding for a variety of projects. For Council District 4, these

April 14th - 16th | On the Streets of Long Beach

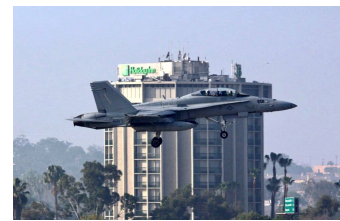

F/A-18 Operations at LGB This Weekend

Thursday - Monday | April 13th - 17th | Long Beach Airport

The U.S. Navy has informed LGB that four (4) F/A-18 aircraft will be conducting operations at Long Beach Airport from Thursday, April 13 through Monday, April 17. The aircraft arrived yesterday and will depart in the afternoon on Monday, but times are tentative and subject to change. LGB is informing the community via WebTrak, social media and their website. Included in the messages to the community is a reminder that these aircraft are exempt from our noise regulations. However, the military has demonstrated a desire in being a good neighbor and are responsive to community concerns.

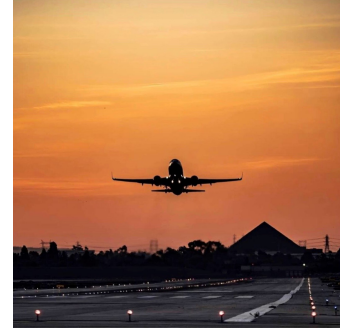
- C-16: Recommendation to adopt resolution authorizing City Manager, or designee, to execute a contract, and any necessary documents including any necessary amendments, with Utility Cost Management, LLC, of Fresno, CA, to perform an electric utility billing audit, in an amount equal to 33 percent of the identified refunds or credits realized by the City of Long Beach (City), and 33 percent of any future savings that accrue during a two year period following implementation of each correction, for a period of two years, with the option to renew for one additional one-year period to complete a second round cost saving review, at the discretion of the City Manager. (Citywide)
- R-27: Recommendation to receive and approve Commission appointments and reappointments for Non-Charter Commissions.
- O-34: Recommendation to declare ordinance amending the Long Beach Municipal Code by amending Sections 10.12.010, 10.12.020, and 10.12.030, all relating to city street speed limits, read the first time and laid over to the next regular meeting of the City Council for final reading. (Citywide)

Main Runway to Close Two Days a Week

In addition to the current nightly closures, LGB's Main Runway 12-30 will begin daily closures next week on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. The duration of the closure will be April 18th through May 24th. Major electrical upgrades designed to improve the safety of the

primary runway are being installed necessitating the temporary runway closures. During Runway 12-30 closures, operations will occur on Runway 8L-26R. 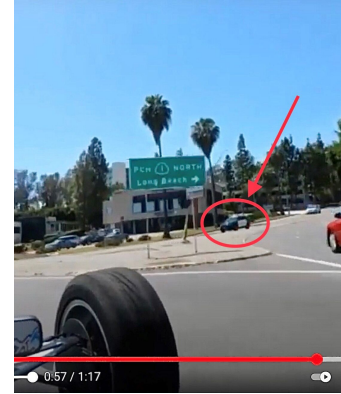

Grand Prix Lap Around the Traffic Circle

Grand Prix Week brings back memories of five years ago when we got to cruise around the council district in a two-seater Indycar. Part of our tour was captured in the attached video as we headed out of the Community Hospital driveway, north on Termino, down the hill on PCH and around the traffic circle. Beginning the second lap, at the 57 second mark, you may see an LBPD unit approaching the circle on PCH. It was no problem, however, because the Indycar was perfectly street legal (in Indiana). Turn up the sound, click on the arrow in the attached video and enjoy the ride around the traffic circle before lane-separating bollards and dashed white lines.
