On Tuesday, we hosted our monthly community meeting at the Los Altos Library. Thanks to our special guest speaker, Long Beach City

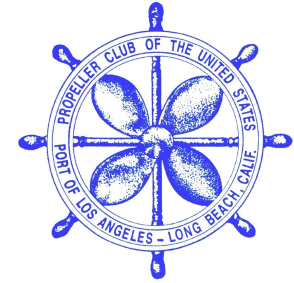

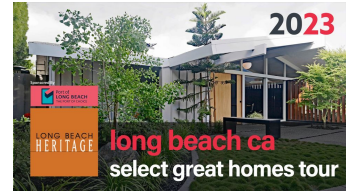

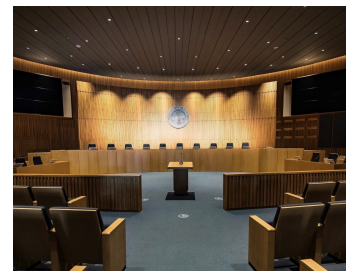

- R-31: Recommendation to adopt resolution in support of the formation of the Lower San Gabriel River Recreation and Park District; direct City Clerk to file the resolution with the Local Area Formation Commission - Los Angeles (LAFCO-LA); and, authorize City Manager to approve the final District Boundary Map on behalf of the City. (Citywide)
