Sidewalk Vending Ordinance Update

This morning, we received an 81-page report from the City Manager on City Council proposed amendments to the Sidewalk Vending Ordinance. The item will be formally agendaized for the November 14th City Council meeting. On May 16, 2023, staff presented Sidewalk Vending Ordinance Recommendations in order to align the Long Beach Municipal Code with Senate Bills 946 and 972 and to codify operating requirements for sidewalk vendors while ensuring public health, safety and welfare. Unlike other, easier-to-remember federal events, like the Fourth

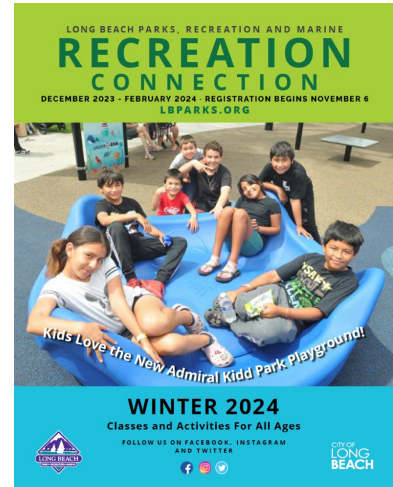
