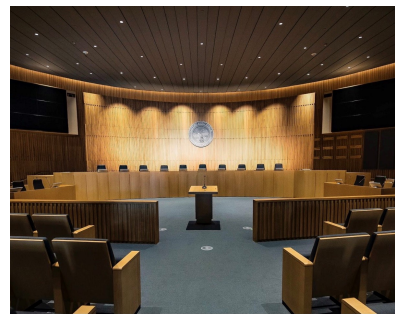

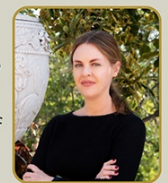
## RLA Lecture on Architect Florence Yoch

### Grand Prix Lap Around the Traffic Circle

It's Grand Prix weekend, and we annually share our memories from six years ago when we got to cruise around the council district in a two-seater Indycar. Part of our tour was captured in the attached video as we headed out of the Community Hospital driveway, north on Termino, down the hill on PCH and around the traffic circle. Beginning the second lap, at the 57 second mark, you may see an LBPD unit approaching the circle on PCH. It was no problem, however, because the Indycar was perfectly street legal (in Indiana). Turn up the sound, click on the arrow in the attached video and enjoy the ride around the traffic circle before lane-separating bollards and dashed white lines.
