Past and Ongoing Events

Update on Short-Term Rental Ordinance

In January, I brought forward legislation requesting the City Manager to present to the City Council a report on our short-term rental ordinance. I also asked for immediate action to be taken on operational adjustments that could be made under the existing ordinance. The report was presented to the City Council for review on Tuesday, April 2nd. A copy of the report can be found [here](#). The [staff presentation](#) included operational and budgetary recommendations to improve enforcement of the STR Ordinance. With a unanimous vote, City Council approved most of the staff recommendations except for increasing fees for residents petitioning the restriction of unhosted STRs within their census tract. April 7th & April 14th | 1 - 4 pm | 2375 Fanwood (Los Arcos side)

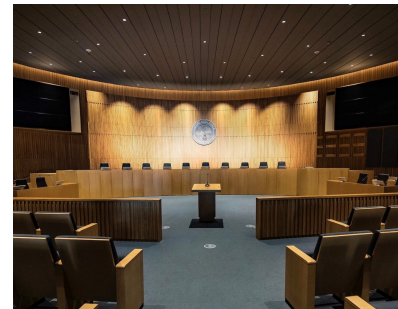

LA County Property Taxes Due Next Wednesday

April 10th | received or postmarked by close of business

Just a friendly reminder that the second installment of Los Angeles Annual Secured Property Tax Bills are due on or before Wednesday, April 10th. Payments must be received or postmarked by close of business on the due date to avoid a 10% late fee. You can also pay by eCheck, but you will need your Assessor's Identification Number (AIN) and Personal Identification Number (PIN), which you can locate on your Secured Property Tax Bill.
