Friday Night, August 16th | 6 - 8 pm | 5620 E Atherton St.

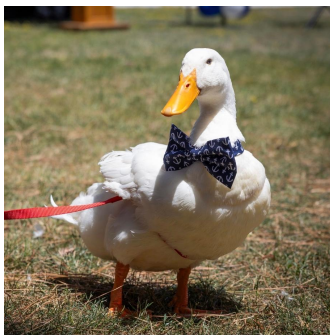

Past and Ongoing Events

City Response to Grants Pass v. Johnson Decision

On June 28th, the Supreme Court reversed the U.S. 9th Circuit Court of Appeals decision in the case of [Johnson v. Grants Pass](#), setting precedent that public agencies can enforce local laws restricting sleeping and/or camping in public spaces. This week, Deputy City Manager, Teresa Chandler, issued a memo with the City's official response. Citations or arrests will be used to address locations where there is a threat to public safety and when other solutions are not working. Enforcement will be used as a tool when appropriate. Long Beach remains committed to leading with compassion and focusing on services that can resolve homelessness. Additional enforcement will be incorporated to resolve encampments that pose significant obstruction to use of public resources like parks, libraries and beaches. New CD4 Funded Washers at Long Beach Animal Care Services

In March, our office was contacted by several residents regarding a broken washing machine at Animal Care Services. District 4 stepped up and worked with ACS staff to have a vendor assess the situation. We found that one washing machine was not sufficient for the number of animals at the shelter and the amount of laundry done daily. We are excited to share that new, CD4 funded washers were recently installed and are already providing much needed support for the shelter. World Mosquito Day (WMD) on August 20th

Tuesday, August 20th, is World Mosquito Day (WMD). They may not be Weapons of Mass Destruction, but these tiny insects kill more than 700,000 people worldwide every year. They are the world's deadliest animal and account for 17% of the estimated global burden of infectious diseases. The Long Beach Department of Health & Human Services has tips on how to prevent the spread of mosquito-borne diseases.
