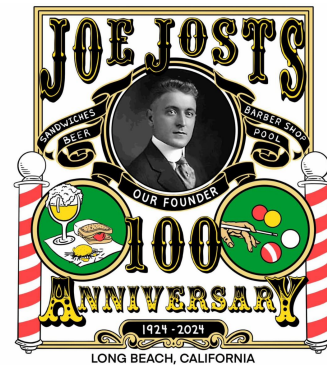

24-hr construction until August 23rd | 24-hour construction

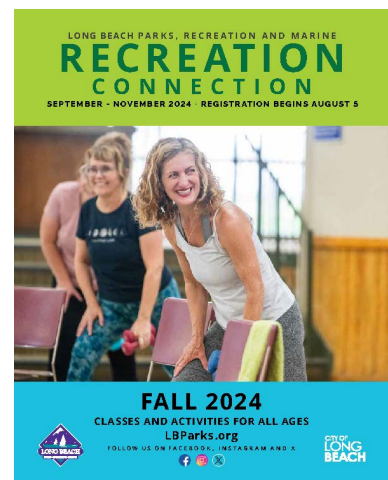
Long Beach Utilities will be conducting 24-hour continuous municipal well construction at El Dorado Park, east of San Gabriel River and south of Long Beach Towne Center. The 24-hour construction will continue through Friday, August 23rd. The work includes removal of one existing water well, drilling, construction, development and testing of two new municipal water wells. No weekend work will be performed. After this work is completed, construction will resume during normal working hours: 7 am to 4:30 pm Monday through Friday excluding holidays. Read the 48-hour notice at this [link](#).

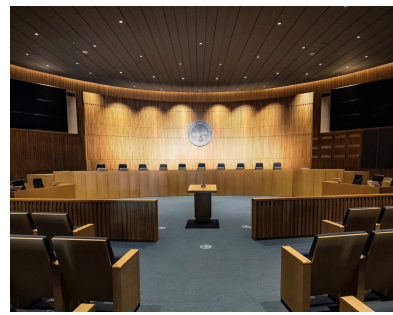

The City Council meeting will start at 5:00 pm in the Civic Chambers on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 411 W. - **C-13:** Recommendation to approve the Fiscal Year 2024 designation of one-time District Priority Funds for City Council District infrastructure projects and existing programs; and approve related budget appropriation adjustments for Fiscal Year 2024 in accordance with existing City Council policy. (Citywide)
- **C-21:** Recommendation to continue the local emergency regarding an outbreak of Tuberculosis (TB) pursuant to Section 2.69.060 of the Long Beach Municipal Code. (Citywide)
- **C-25:** Recommendation to authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute all documents, including any necessary amendments, with the Federal Aviation Administration, to accept the Federal Aviation Administration Airport Zero Emissions Vehicle and Infrastructure Pilot Program grant funds for federal Fiscal Year 2024 funding, for the acquisition of six electric airside operations vehicles and two solar-tree chargers, in an amount not to exceed \$782,980. (Districts 4, 5)
- **CBH:** Recommendation to conduct a Budget Hearing to receive and discuss an overview of the Proposed Fiscal Year 2025 Budget for the departments of Police and Fire. (Citywide)
