11-Day Vote Centers Open This Weekend

Vote centers for the March 5th Primary Nominating Election are open tomorrow February 24th for in-person voting. Vote centers will be open from 10 am - 7 pm until March 4th. On Election Day, March 5th, all Vote Centers will be open from 7 am to 8 pm. CD4 has one 11-day voting center at the International City Masonic Center (5155 E Pacific Coast Hwy). Vote by Mail ballots have also been distributed and may be returned by mail (no postage required), in person at any Vote Center in Los Angeles County, or at any Vote by Mail Ballot Drop Box. There are 17 drop box locations throughout Long Beach, and Council District 4 locations include the Dr. Thomas J. Clark Community Center and Stearns Park. Cub Scout Pack 88 Visits City Hall

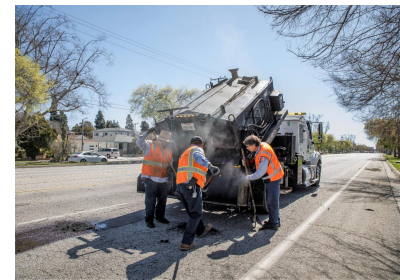

March 9th | 10 am - 2 pm | 2929 E Willow St.

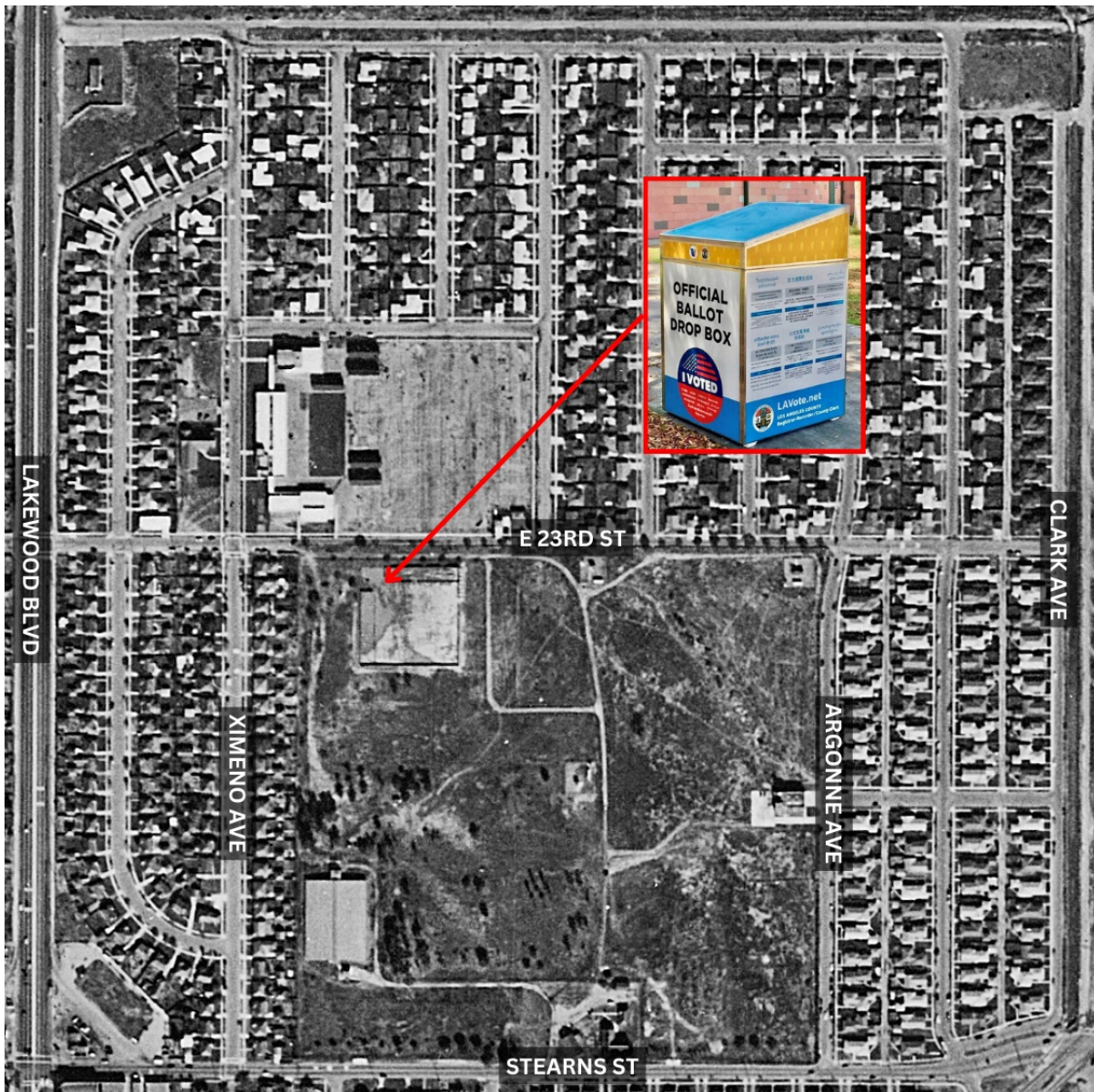

The Long History of LB Little League's Opening Day

Long Beach Little League's Opening Day tomorrow will be the 72nd edition. The opening year was 1952, and that predates the creation Stearns Park. The original field at that time was located in a vacant lot adjacent to 23rd Street at the approximate location of the current Community Center. It's also where one of CD4's ballot drop boxes is located. If you happen to place your ballot in the drop box tomorrow, you'll be standing in the area of the original home plate.
