F/A-18 Operations at LGB for Fleet Week

Heads up! Three F/A-18s will conduct several operations at Long Beach Airport (LGB) for Los Angeles Fleet Week between Thursday (5/23) afternoon and Tuesday (5/28) morning. Times are tentative & subject to change. F/A-18s are significantly louder than aircraft that typically operate at LGB. Military aircraft are exempt from noise regulations, but they will be using noise abatement procedures in the Long Beach area.
