The City Council meeting will start at 5:00 pm in the Civic Chambers on the ground floor of City Hall, located at 411 W. - **C-22:** Recommendation to authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute all documents necessary to amend Contract No. 35531 with Anser Advisory, LLC (formerly DBA Simplus Management LLC), of Santa Ana, CA, for providing construction management services for the Phase II Terminal Area Improvements at Long Beach Airport, to increase the contract amount by \$198,000, for a revised contract amount not to exceed \$11,583,343; and increase appropriations in the Airport Fund Group in the Airport Department by \$198,000, offset by Airport operating revenues. - **C-27:** Recommendation to receive and file the application of Alma Tacos LLC, dba Alma,

for an original application of an Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) License, at 5514 Britton Drive; submit a Public Notice of Protest to ABC and direct City Manager to withdraw the protest if a Conditional Use Permit Exemption (CUPEX) is granted. (District 4)

- [C-28](#): Recommendation to receive and file the application of Forty Niner Shops, Incorporated, dba Carpenter Performing Arts Center, for an original application of an Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) License, at 6200 Atherton Street and determine that the application serves the Public Convenience and Necessity. (District 4)
- [C-30](#): Recommendation to authorize City Manager, or designee, to execute all documents necessary to amend Contract No. 36159 with Select Electric, Inc., of Vista, CA, for construction work on the Ten Signalized Intersections on Los Coyotes Diagonal Project, to increase the construction contract contingency amount by \$42,272, for a revised contract amount not to exceed \$1,359,522. (Districts 4, 5)

It was a very different election night watch party on Tuesday than we experienced on March 5th. It was apparent from the very first LA County posting that we had all the votes necessary to secure a victory. First and foremost, I would like to thank all those who backed our campaign and to all the CD4 voters who supported me in record numbers. As of yesterday, the total number of votes cast for my reelection was 11,187. That is already a record breaking amount of votes for Council District 4. As that number grows in the coming days, we'll know if we've broken a citywide record. It's a lot more fun waiting to see if you broke a record as opposed to waiting to make the 50% required to avoid a runoff.
