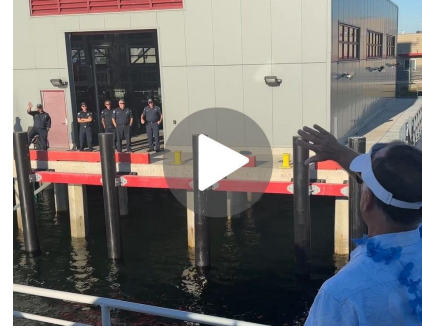

Corday Concert at the Nature Center



The Kilroy/Aero Star

Have you ever noticed the brightly illuminated star on the north side of the 405 at the Kilroy/Aero complex between Lakewood Blvd. and Redondo Ave.? Here is how it got there: In 2020, the isolating times of the pandemic cast a shadow over Kilroy's traditional holiday celebrations. With their commitment to placemaking and connection, the stars were born. The 20' light sculptures were placed atop their properties to serve as a reminder of optimism and resilience.
