In 1969, a Porsche dealership opened at the traffic circle, and it shared a showroom with Circle Volkswagen at 1919 Lakewood Blvd. The following year, Circle Porsche moved to 4400 Los Coyotes Diagonal where CVS is now located. They later moved into a converted LA Fitness gym at 1850 Outer Traffic Circle where the dealership remained for many years. Now, 56 years later, a new chapter begins with a beautiful new showroom. 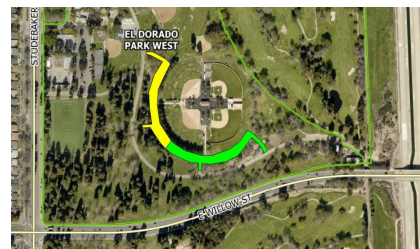

The project at the traffic circle in Council District 4 is built with 21,000 square feet of the GreenGirt CMH continuous insulation system. Our council office was able to provide assistance during construction to the architectural firm, Gensler, general contractor, Dempsey Construction, and owner, Fletcher Jones, III.
