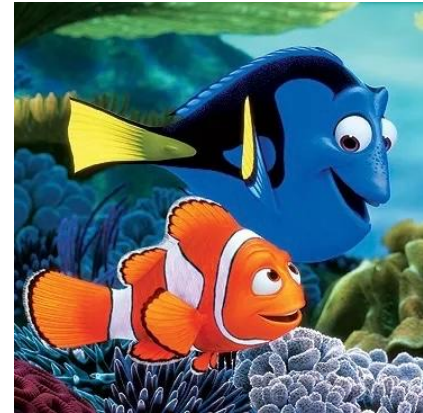

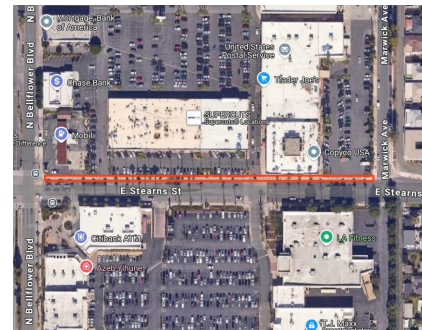

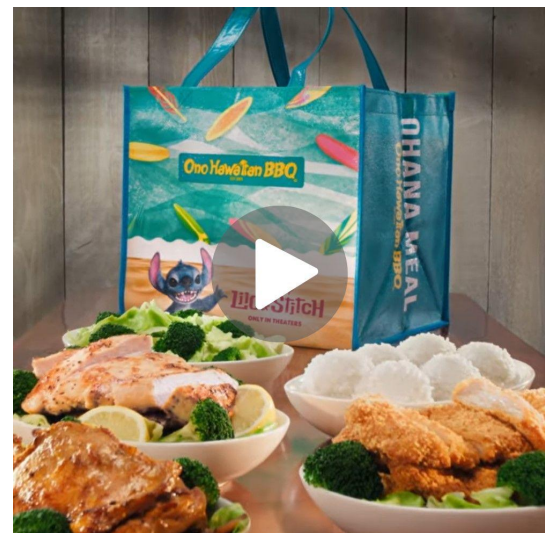

Ono Hawaiian BBQ Grand Opening in CD4!

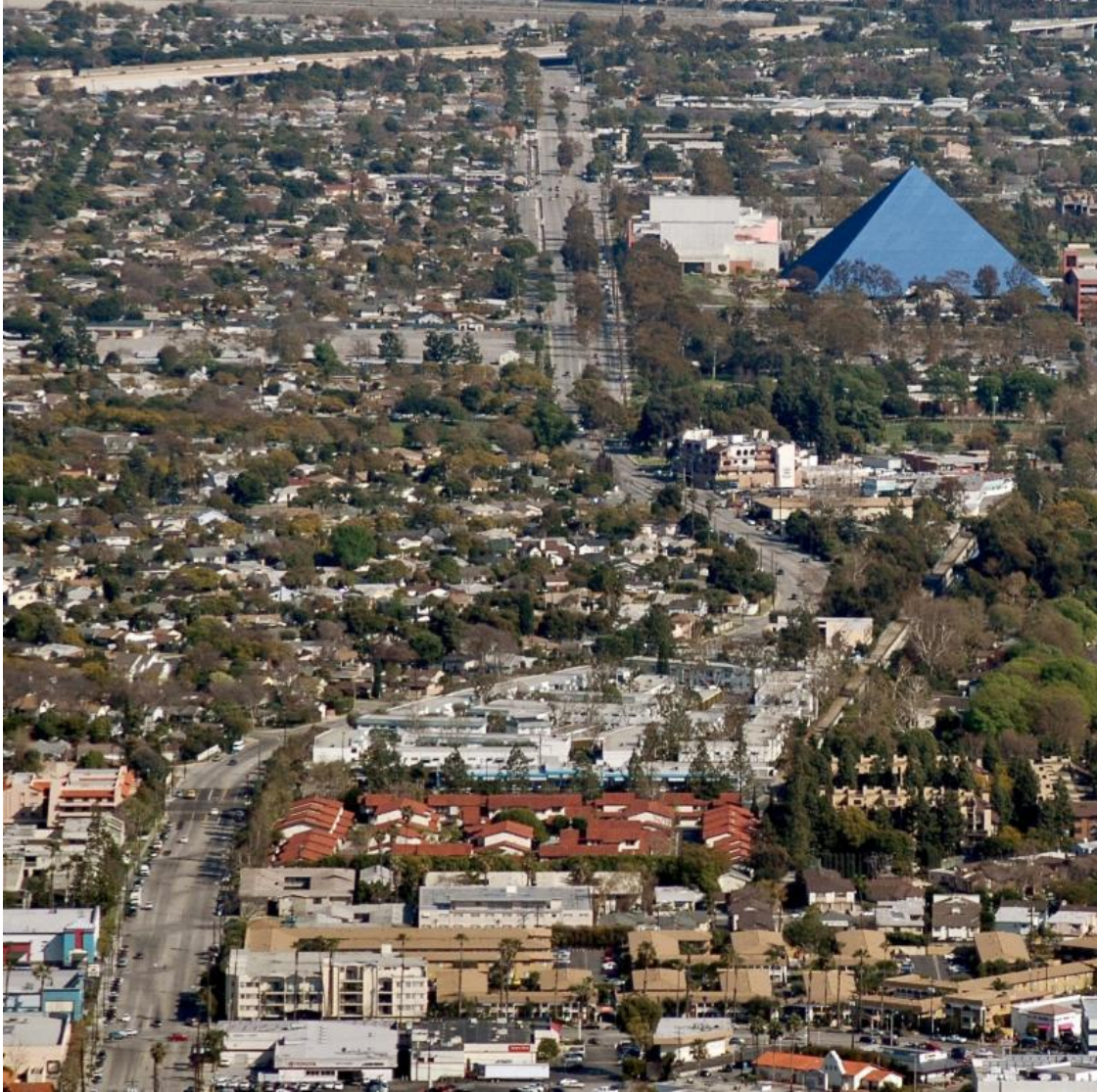
