<b>Tar &amp; Gravel</b>	Ranch, International	None
<b>Wood Shakes</b>	Neo-Traditional, Ranch	Sawed, split
<b>Wood Shingles</b>	Original to Victorian, Queen Anne, Transitional, Colonial Revival, American Foursquare, Craftsman	Fishscale, diamond, octagon, hexagon, plain, variegated
<b>Composition Shingles</b>	Preferred substitute for wood shingles on Victorian, Queen Anne, Mass Plan, Transitional, Colonial Revival, American Foursquare, Craftsman.	Fishscale, diamond, octagon, hexagon, plain, variegated. <b>No MIDNIGHT OR BLACK shingles allowed.</b>
<b>Metal</b>	Industrial, Modern/Contemporary	Batten, ribbed, standing seam, corrugated
<b>Roll Roofing</b>	Budget substitute for composition shingles inappropriate for most style dwellings except Art Deco, Streamline Moderne style properties with parapets	None

\*Note location of drip edges, gutters, downspouts, etc. They should be placed as inconspicuously as possible and finished to match color of roofing material and/or house trim.
