NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING: On Monday, October 7, 2024, at 4:00 p.m., The Long Beach Community Investment Company will conduct a public hearing in the 2nd Floor Large Conference Room, City Hall, 411 W. Ocean Blvd., Long Beach.

The purpose of the public hearing will be to receive public comments on the Pathways to Removing Obstacles (PRO Housing) Application. PRO Housing is a competitive grant program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and is intended to identify and remove barriers to affordable housing production and preservation. The proposed activities include housing development in high-resource areas through new construction, acquisition, and rehabilitation of existing multifamily units as well as providing funding to the Community Land Trust program for a combined total amount of \$7,000,000.

Draft copies of the PRO Housing Application will be made available starting from September 30, 2024 for 15-day public comment on the "Latest News" section of the Development Services web page at <http://www.longbeach.gov/lbds>.

The City of Long Beach intends to provide reasonable accommodation for the Public Hearing in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990.
