You are invited to join the conversation about updates to the City's Zoning Code addressing land use regulations related to the significant need for interim housing, supportive housing, and related supportive services. These updates will bring Long Beach into compliance with California state law, while creating more flexible definitions and operating standards that allow service providers to address emerging needs while maintaining best practices, public health, and public safety. They will also remove redundant or overly restrictive standards, while ensuring equal opportunity for these crucial services across the City.

Proposed updates include:

- Creating an "Interim Housing" definition, encompassing all temporary sleeping or rooming accommodations, such as Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, and Bridge Housing.
- Creating Interim Housing operating standards to ensure best practices, public health, and public safety.
- Creating a "Safe Parking" definition and operating standards.
- Removing an outdated "Shelters" definition.
- Clarifying definitions of "Emergency Shelter," "Supportive Housing," and "Social Service Office," and expanding opportunities where these uses are permitted.

Both meetings will include opportunities to review and comment on specific updates.
