LGB SECURITY VEHICLE DECALS

PURPOSE

This bulletin serves as a friendly reminder that street legal vehicles must have a Vehicle Decal when operating in Decal Access Areas. (Decal Areas)

BACKGROUND

On March 1, 2021, the Long Beach Airport (LGB) notified airport partners that the Vehicle Identification Decal Program was updated to comply with Federal regulations. This update better defined the program's requirements, provided new decals that are easily recognizable, and offered the community greater flexibility when operating in Decal Areas.

At LGB, Decal Areas include the Perimeter Road inside the Air Operations Area (AOA) fence line and the commercial passenger aircraft ramp in the Secured Area/Security Identification Display Area (SIDA). Decals are not required to operate on tenant leaseholds.

To comply with Federal regulations, please ensure that street legal vehicles operating in Decal Areas have a Vehicle Decal. Failure to adhere to the Decal program policies may result in a Notice of Violation (NOV) and possible civil penalties from the Transportation Security Administration (TSA). Vehicles found operating without a decal should immediately be reported to the Airport Communications Center at 562-570-2646.
