



TIC-TAC-TOSS MAT

WHAT YOU NEED

- Two colors of poster board cut into 10-inch squares
- Clear contact paper
- 10 plastic lids or large, heavy buttons in two colors

WHAT YOU DO

1. Place the poster board squares on strips of clear contact paper to make three rows of alternating colors
2. Cover the top of the squares with clear contact paper to connect the rows
3. Toss the lids or buttons onto the mat to see who can be the first to get three in a row
