Rail Car – Activation Opportunity

- CLB will be seeking a partner to activate the Rail Car
 - Separate Community Outreach process to determine use
 - Exploring interim use until final use becomes clear
- Further connects Downtown and East Village and promotes livability, placemaking
 - Activation efforts reduce concerns of safety and unwanted activity
 - Preserves history of Blue Line Rail Car here in Long Beach

Project Impacts

- Construction will be phased to reduce impacts to access
- Temporary closures or relocations
- Loss of parking from sidewalk widening and street realignment
