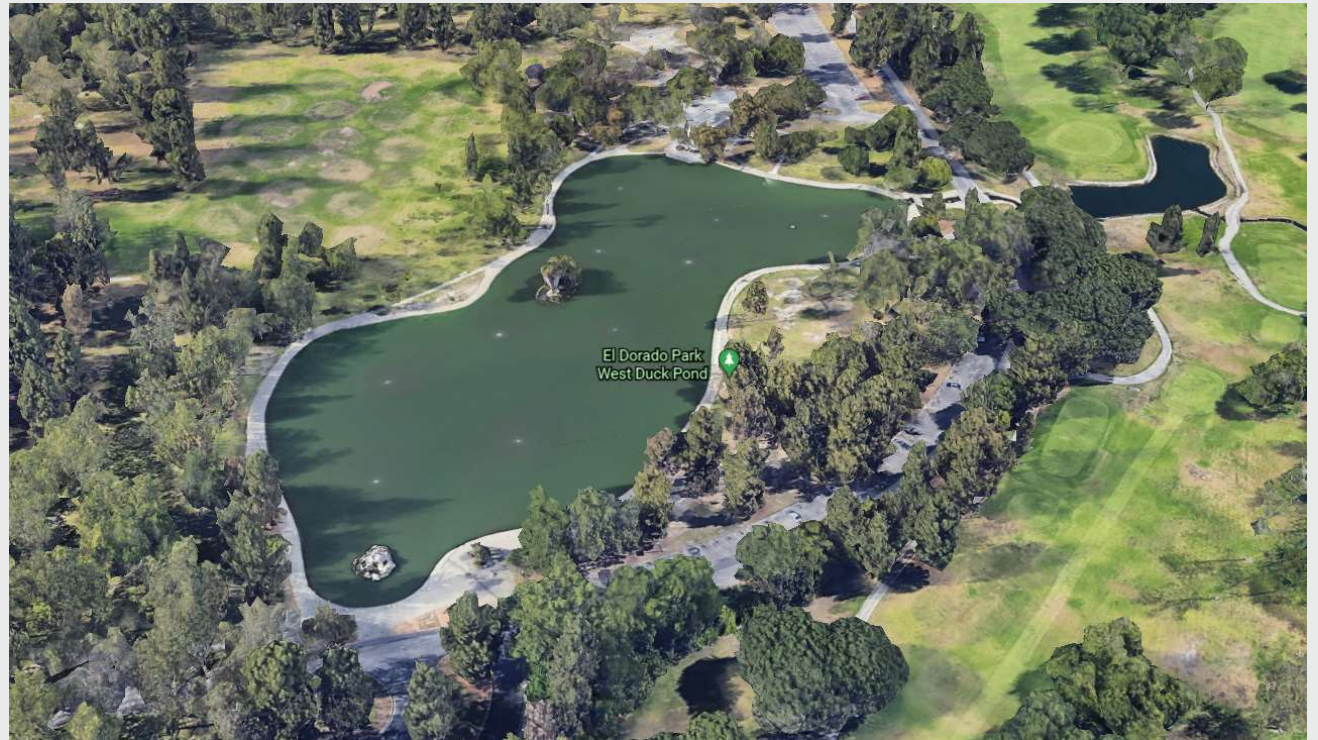

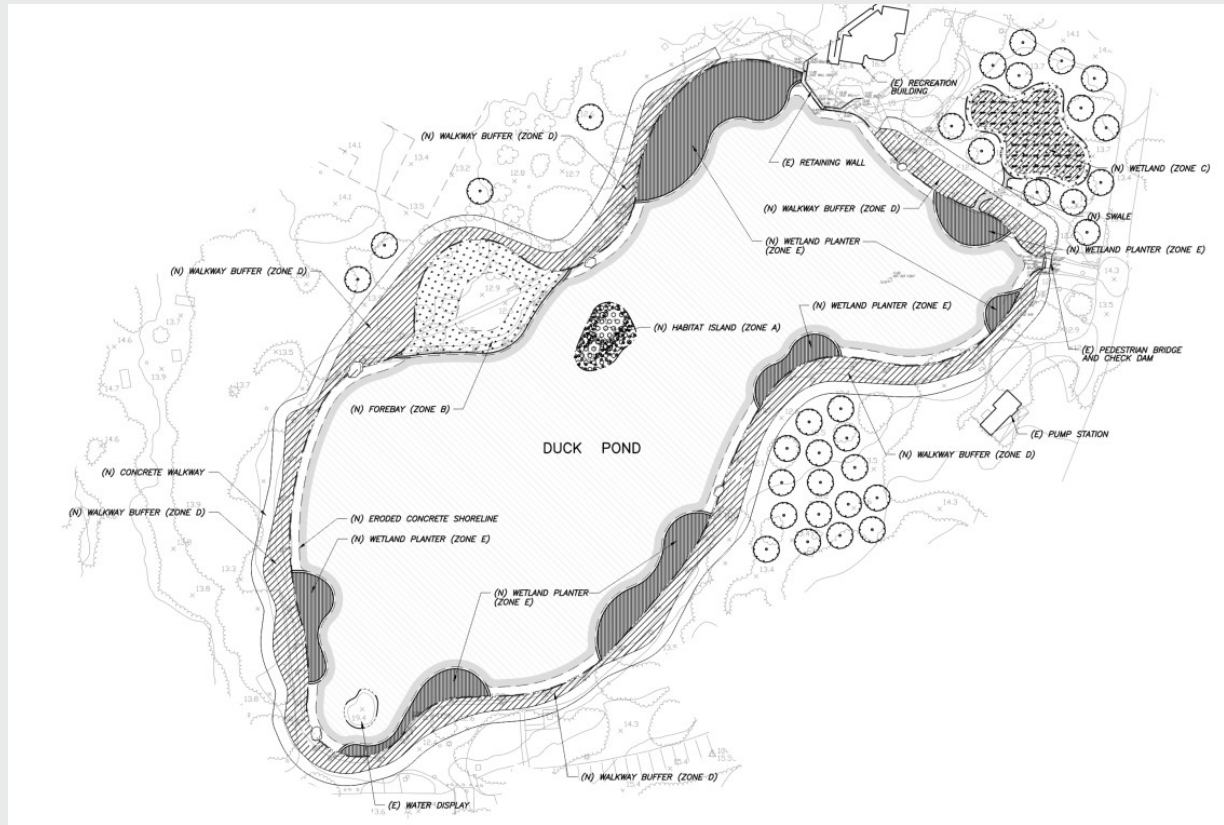

## Question & Answer

- What is the plan for replacement of the walkway/paving and lake bottom?
- Will the renovation blue print/plan be posted for public viewing?
- Will any current amenities (parking, playground, picnic or other reservable areas) be closed during the project and if so for how long?
- As they are connected, will there be any impact to the stream and lake at El Dorado Park Golf Course?
- What is the plan for relocation of all the ducks, geese, herons, and turtles that live in the Duck Pond area?
- Who will do the relocation and how were they selected? Where will the animals be taken?
- Once the project is completed will the animals come back to their original home or will they stay at their new habitat?
- What department/staff will monitor the relocation?
- The palms on the island in the pond are a nationally known snowy egret and black crown nesting area. How will this essential rookery be protected?
- How will the Federal Migratory Bird Act be enforced?
- How can we better enforce “no feeding” of wildlife/ducks in the area? Are there plans for updated signage included in the improvements?
- Is there a study performed on endangered species and wildlife counts prior to relocation?
- When will this item go to City Council for approval and what is the construction timeline?
- What are the funding sources?
