On March 16, 2021, the City Council approved the Long Beach Recovery Act, becoming one of the first major cities to approve a COVID-19 recovery program utilizing federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. The Long Beach Recovery Act funds a number of major economic, public health, and fiscal programs for Long Beach residents, business owners and workers critically impacted by the pandemic. 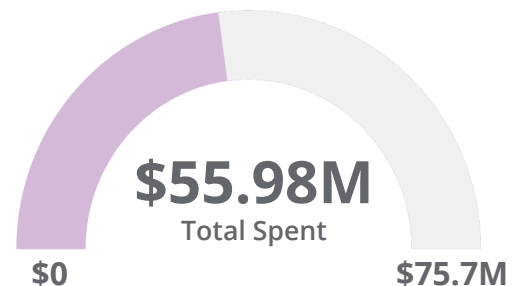
